Who Can Apply

Piano Rental

Piano Institute students may borrow an electric keyboard for the full 8-month program. A separate rental contract will be signed upon registration. Instruments must be returned in their original condition at the end of the program.

Scholarship Information

Students may receive a full scholarship based on annual household income. Families earning \$0-\$40,000 annually are eligible. A copy of the family's 2024 income tax return is required with the application.
